President's Message

President's message.

My fingers have been cold, but my heart burns with warmth.

I am working on a large cycle of paintings, and my studio has little heat. I am painting a night procession, you see. The grand design is composed of thirty-three wooden panels, each measuring seven feet high and three feet wide, so it is a big task. The final assembly of panels will be 99 feet long. Each panel depicts groups of people standing or marching through a cold assailing darkness, each holding in their hand a blazing, lit candle.

It stands for something big. Something bigger than me, and not just in physical size, but in the scope of its narrative. I am painting life-sized figures of impassioned women, angelic children and sleeping babies; old wrinkled grandparents and muscular men. They are fathers, doing their best to stand strong.

I could tell you that these figures huddled in the turbulent cold symbolize religious march, that they are perhaps enacting a civic ritual, or reflecting of a specific culture. But my painted figures are growing beyond these tidy descriptions. They are becoming us- all of us. And above all, they are beginning to represent the purest form of their appearance. They are keepers of warmth and love in a world of challenging, moving forces. The forces are magical as dreams and as dark as fear and destruction.

Their candles represent the simplest of iconography: hope. But my figures are not scared, of the darkness. They each make their stand, even in the face of the unknown. They seem to be demanding not to be painted in attitudes of mock-bravery in the face of fear, but in attitudes of acceptance that they are merely, gloriously human. And so I see the calendar on my wall, quietly reminding us all that it is time once again for the Holidays. With my cold fingers and my full, warm heart I continue to paint these figures, knowing only that they represent the hope in the darkness that these Holidays carry at their core: The promise that the cold is not forever and the light is really stronger than we can imagine.

And speaking of warmth and light, it is time to reserve your seat at our annual winter brunch, held this coming February at the impossibly romantic (and happily affordable)Café Bizou. We sold out last year and had to turn many away due to the demand, so be sure to respond right away! A special reservation form to fill out and send in will be in your mail. Look for it! The food at Café Bizou is legendary....it is soooo good, and our guest artist this year is famed painter Junn Roca. An elegant and enjoyable time will be had by all. (And how nice to have it scheduled after the hustle and bustle !

Remember: There is no meeting this December! Take the month to create, and enjoy the season. Stay warm, fellow artists! Let the light surround you.
