Quinton Bemiller is a painter and teacher working in Los Angeles. In 2010, Bemiller completed three major projects. The first was *Hahamongna*, a mural at the Armory Center for the Arts, Pasadena, supported by a grant from Pasadena's Department of Cultural Affairs. The second project was a commis-



sion from the City of Los Angeles for a Public Art Project in the form of a solo exhibition entitled Subsequent Events, at Los Angeles International Airport. In September/October, Bemiller's Kusama Trees series was presented by Offramp Gallery, Pasadena, featuring an illustrated catalog with essay by Armory Center for the Arts Curator, Sinead Finnerty Pyne. Other exhibitions include solo or group shows at Torrance Art Museum, Laguna Art Museum, Santa Monica Art Museum, Kellogg Gallery at Cal Poly Pomona University, Fullerton Museum of Art at Cal State University, San Bernardino, 808 Gallery at Boston University, Plant Zero in Richmond, Virginia, and Gallery 825, Los Angeles. Bemiller teaches painting in his Chinatown studio and art history at Chaffey College, Rancho Cucamonga. He organizes art tours locally and nationally and gives lectures and demonstrations throughout Southern California. Bemiller studied at Pasadena City College, The Art Institute of Boston at Lesley University and Claremont Graduate University, where he received his MFA in Painting in 2007. He lives with his wife Megann, also an artist, and their three daughters, Lillie, Jade and Violet.
